## Directions – Medical Cost Analysis Worksheets

These worksheets serve to calculate out-of-pocket costs for hospital and medical care from the time OEA coverage was lost. Medicare Summary Notices (MSNs) should be used as the primary source of service information. Hospital and medical bills may also be useful, but are often confusing and do not always accurately reflect Medicare allowable charges for services. Keep all MSNs, EOBs, bills for service, and all other source documents in a safe place. **You must include copies of these supporting documents along with the worksheets when you submit them to the Staff Education Association Retiree VEBA (SEARV).**

**Date of Service - Best source - MSN**

**Provider Name - Not required because of confidentiality issues - Best Source - MSN**

**Amount Charged - Best Source - MSN**

**Medicare Allowable - Best Source - MSN**

**Medicare Paid - Best Source - MSN**

**Remaining Balance -Best Source - MSN - Listed under the heading “You May be Billed”**

**Amount Paid -Your out-of-pocket cost for the service**

**Use as many worksheets as needed to list all your hospital and medical charges. Please total the costs listed on each worksheet sheet before they are submitted to SEARV.**
